Internal Transfer (Department Changed) Students

Credit Recognition for the international transfer students includes:

- Designing University Life and Career (대학생활과진로설계) course
- Courses whose language of instruction is English.
- Courses falls into any of the following:
 - Second language related courses, excluding native language courses
 - Community Service (사회봉사) courses, **limited to two courses**
 - Career, Self-development, and Business-related courses (진로선택/자기계발/창업 영역) within the university's balanced liberal arts curriculum, **limited to two courses**
 - Special Education Program courses, upto 12 credits

Transfer Students

Credit transfer and the number of credits to be completed for graduation vary depending on the year of admission. Please see the details below.

- ② If an elective course has been changed to a required major course after admission
- ③ If new required major courses have been added after admission
